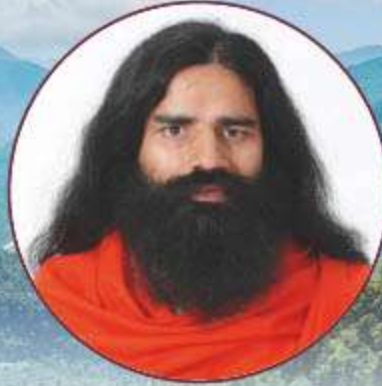

The 52nd session of the All India Oriental Conference (AIOC) will be jointly organized by University of Patanjali, Central Sanskrit University and Bharatiya Vidvat Parishad. This year's conference will spotlight 18 themes across various disciplines of Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS), promising a literary and cultural extravaganza that will offer attendees a lifetime experience. The focal point of this year's conference is the celebration of India's eternal Vaidik heritage, which aligns beautifully with the divine sankalpa of Param Pujya Yogarshi Swami Ramdev Ji Maharaj and Param Shraddheya Ayurveda Shiromani Acharya Balakrishna Ji.

AIOC was established in 1918 by the visionary founders of the Bhandarkar Oriental Research Institute (BORI) and the first AIOC held at Shimla, Himachal Pradesh in 1919. Since its inception, AIOC has made significant contributions to IKS. With a 100+ years of history it has successfully organized 51 sessions and has produced numerous publications and conference proceedings that have greatly enriched the literary world. This year, AIOC proudly hosts its 52nd session at one of the sapta moksha puris, Haridwar.

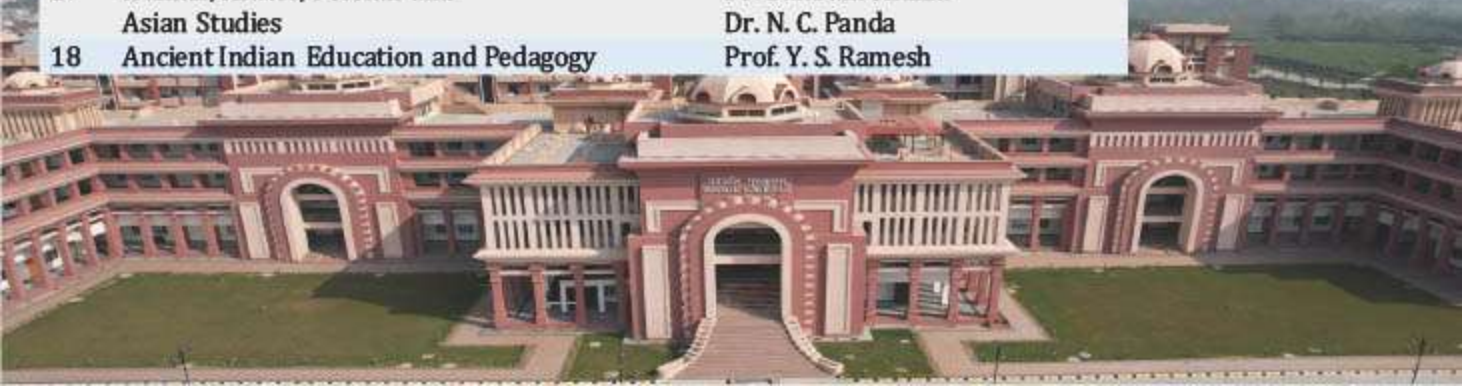
